

Criteria for Offering Proposals for 2022 LWML Michigan District Convention

Requirements for a Ministry to be considered

- The funds must be able to be administered by an entity of the LCMS, a Recognized Service Organization (RSO) of the LCMS or a partner church body.
- The ministry/mission must fit the goals and tenets of the LCMS church body and the goals of the LWML.
- Documentation of the Ministry Required.
- Submit the "Proposal for 2022 Convention Offering" form.
- Include all Contact Information for both the submitter and the proposed recipient.
- Include contact information to which the funds are to be sent, such as the name of the ministry and their street address, telephone number; e-mail contact and who the person is that would receive the funds.
- If the recipient is located outside the Michigan District the endorsement of the District President or the affiliated ministry head is required. Foreign Mission will require okay from World Missions and President of affiliated national Lutheran church. This will require more time so make sure you allow this extra time to obtain signatures.
- Include 2 or more letters of support of those who are familiar with this ministry if not a well-recognized one.
- A short history of the ministry if unknown by most.
