Joseph County. Speaker will be Keara Hilton, addressing psychological healing from her abortion. Everyone is welcome and invited to attend, including a reception.










Another mission tour is planned for October which will showcase many urban churches/charities. Contact Karen McClelland (586-345-7763) if interested in joining them.
