At the Spring Fling and the Prayer Service a few weeks later, 100 kits were assembled and packed. It soon became evident that these kits were not going to fit in the car to take to Milwaukee.

So arrangements were made to deliver them to Rev. Reed in Sebewaing. On August 1st several ladies from the zone took a road trip to visit the facility and deliver the hygiene kits. Zone President Karen said she couldn't have been prouder of the 8 participating churches that worked together to make 100 kits.

MISSION GRANT HIGHLIGHT

Expanding Christ's Love for the Aging & Unchurched in Michigan Worship Anew (Lutheran Ministries Media) - \$25,000

Through Lutheran Ministries Media, Worship Anew was originally under the name Worship for Shut-Ins and began airing in 1965. This is a 30-minute weekly television program which follows the biblical doctrine as presented in the Lutheran Confessions and articulated in the Book of Concord.

Worship Anew is taking God's Word to a growing population of the aging, unchurched, and those in need of hearing the Gospel (Mark 16:15). They seek to expand the sharing of Christ's love through television ministry in Michigan. Currently, Worship Anew broadcasts on ten television markets throughout

Michigan: Battle Creek, Detroit, Frankenmuth, Grand Rapids, Kalamazoo, Lansing, Monroe, Oakland/Livonia, Portage and Saginaw. They also reach people in southwest Michigan through affiliates in South Bend, Indiana and Chicago, Illinois and in southeast Michigan through affiliate in Toledo, Ohio. Worship Anew is requesting a \$25,000 Grant to expand their ministry on local broadcast television. With God's blessing and through the support of LWML Michigan District, they will continue to grow and reach more people in Michigan in the coming years.
