

Everything is free and you can easily print it from your computer and make copies for groups! Mission Spotlight

New Shepherds for South Sudan (Lutheran Heritage Foundation) – \$18,000 – Paid in full!




The people of South Sudan are in need of the Gospel, living in extreme poverty, civil war, famine, and disease, with average life expectancy of only 56 years. The evangelical Lutheran Church in South Sudan (ELCSS) has more than 200 congregations, but fewer than 80 pastors to serve them. Need for new pastors is great, as each pastor is responsible for preaching God's Word to at least three congregations, often long distances apart. Lutheran Heritage Foundation in Macomb, MI, has partnered with ELCSS to establish a seminary, The Concordia Lutheran Institute for the Holy Ministry (CLIHM) to provide theological education for new pastors. These CLIHM seminarians come from extreme poverty and do not have funds to cover educational costs. This grant has supported five South Sudan seminarians for one year, providing tuition, supplies, room, and board!

LWML Evergreen Zone Fall Retreat

The Evergreen Zone hosted its Fall Retreat on Saturday, October 18, 2025, at Trinity Lutheran Church, Utica, Michigan. The theme for the event was "Welcoming All, Valuing Everyone." This was based on the organization featured that day and its founder, Todd Gordon, from WAVE Project. They provide a shower trailer and an essentials van that travel around Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb Counties, serving people on the margins. Over the years, they have sponsored more than 4,000 showers, along with toiletries and clean clothing for the needy. They also ran a warming shelter for the homeless at Trinity Lutheran Church in Warren last winter. Todd's message told us to 1. Live a life marked with Jesus and strive to spend time with Him. 2. Become like Him. 3. Do what He did. "Let Him love you into a person of God." Remember the scripture, "Whatever you did for the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." Matthew 25:40. Motown Soup was sold, and a share of the profits from the sales will go toward our Mite Grant goals.
